ment quarters in North Quincy and began holding its monthly meetings at the Nickerson Post on March 1, 2024. Caddy Detachment Commandant Timothy Carroll holds monthly meetings at the Nickerson Post on

the first Saturday of the month at 1:00 PM (except July & August). Originally named the South Shore Detachment, returning Marines from WWII got together in 1946 and decided to start a new Marine Corps League Detachment in the City of Quincy in honor of PFC William R. Caddy, USMCR, who was from the Montclair neighborhood. PFC Caddy was

assigned to Company I, Third Battalion, 26th Marines, Fifth Marine Division and was awarded the Medal of Honor, posthumously, for his actions against Japanese Forces on Iwo Jima on March 3, 1945. The William R. Caddy Detachment #124 received its National MCL Charter on October 10, 1946 and consists of Regular (annual) and Life members; all verified USMC & FMF Navy veterans (DD Form 214). The mission of the Marine Corps League is to promote the interest and

to preserve traditions of the United States Marine Corps; strengthen the fraternity of Marines and their families; serve Marines and Fleet Marine Force (FMF) Navy Personnel who wear or who have worn the Eagle, Globe and Anchor; and foster the

ideals of Americanism and patriotic volunteerism. 
