A Note from our Post History – Part Two Nike Missile Site B0-37 Squantum/Long Island.



For almost 20 years, Nike missile batteries formed a suburban ring around Boston that ushered the city into the 1950s and the atomic age. The ring of bases stretched from the South Shore to the

North Shore and far inland, always ready to fire in 15 minutes or less. The Nike Missile Site BO-37 Squantum/Long Island was the launch site for a battery of Nike Ajax missiles, active between 1955 and 1961, one of fifteen Nike Missile sites operated in Massachusetts between the

1950's and the 1970's to defend coastal

urban areas against aerial attack. Missiles were stored underground and launched from the area now covered by a concrete slab. This launch complex was on Long Island, while the control center for the battery was on the mainland where the post is currently located today. The site had the following weapon systems: Nike Ajax / 20 (10 per launcher section), 8 mounted on launchers (4 per launcher section). Below on the left is a aerial view of the Post (known as the IFC= Integrated Fire Control Area. On the right is an aerial view of Launcher Area on Long Island in Boston Harbor. View is looking southwest. Boston Harbor is to the right, Quincy Bay to the left. The IFC was located down the road

cutting across the picture to the right. 12 August 1959.

Massachusetts Veterans can receive a \$400 abatement on their annual property taxes if they meet one of the following criteria: 1. Veterans with a service-connected disability of 10% or more.

2. Veterans awarded the Purple Heart.

3. Surviving parents of military personnel who died in military service (Gold Star Parents).

4. Spouses (where the domicile is owned by the veteran's spouse), and surviving spouses (who have never remarried), of veterans entitled to exemption under Clause 22.

5. Surviving spouses (who have never remarried) of World War I veterans as long as their assets (whole worth), less any mortgage on the property, do not exceed \$20,000.
